

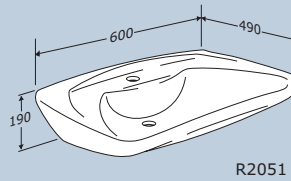
Wash basin and toilet

The size and shape of the wash basin should ensure that seated as well as standing users can reach the running water as well as use the tap. For the user to have a stable seating position, it is important that the sitting height of the toilet is correct. A standard toilet height does not necessarily suit everybody. A high toilet could be an alternative choice, or a wallhung toilet that can be installed to suit the user.

Ergonomic wash basin

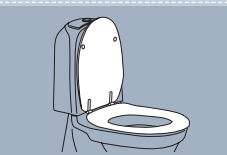
Without overflow **R2051000**

The concave front edge stabilises a standing as well as a seated user. The rounded shapes are nice to grip and lean against. The design of the corners leaves space and supports the elbows in the basin and the flat bottom leaves space for the legs of a seated user.



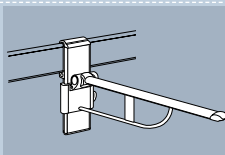

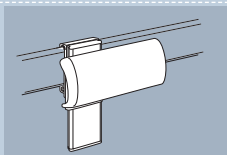

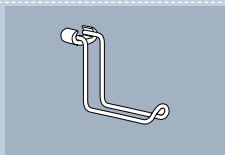
